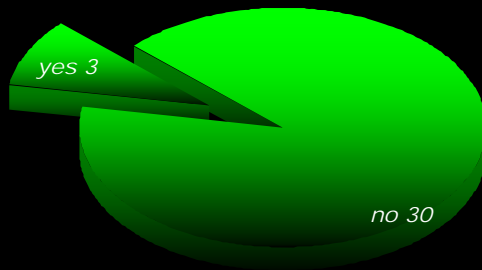

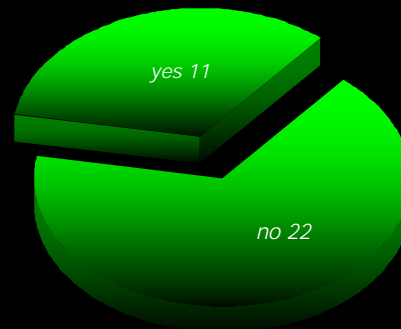

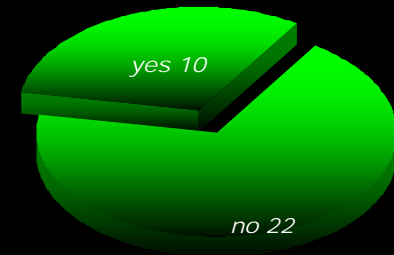
By Grants?
